Surgical Pack Assembly Room Quality Standards

Quality Standards: The following criteria meets all regulatory recommendations and/or standards and shall be used to determine if an item is acceptable or unacceptable for use in the surgical setting.

Surgical Towels	No quality defects are acceptable.	Any foreign adhering materialsLint or hair	DiscolorationAny foreign adhering materials

Member Responsibility: Anything stuck to a surgical product must be removed from the product prior to depositing in the soil bin. Examples: Tape, EKG patches.
